# (c) 12 Thames Street, Wallingford, OX10 0HD P23/S2421/LDL

The entire building, including the historic, solid walled parts of the property, is currently pointed in inappropriate cementitious mortar; it is proposed to rake out the cementitious mortar (to a depth no less than 2x the height of the joint), and repoint using non-hydraulic hot mixed lime mortar.

**RECOMMENDED** that this application be granted, subject to an appropriate method be used to extract the existing cementitious mortar

# (d) 1 St Martin's Street (Car Park), Wallingford, OX10 0EF P23/S2665/TCA

Silver Birch - Prune back all trees that are obstructing the CCTV cameras by approx 1m. The crowns of the trees will not be reduced.
