The Annual Town Meeting is a meeting of residents, facilitated by the Town Council

- 1. Welcome and introduction from the Mayor, Councillor Dan Beauchamp
- 2. Town, District and County Councillors to introduce themselves
- 3. Explanation of process by meeting facilitator, Nick Sandall

The following themes and topics will then be considered. The order has been determined by a drawing of lots.

- 4. Arts, culture and heritage, including major public events and significant buildings
- 5. Environment and sustainability, including new housing, infrastructure, parks, allotments, litter and open spaces
- 6. Getting around, including highways, bus services, traffic flow, speed limits, crossings and traffic lights
- 7. Health, well-being and safety, including anti-social behaviour and crime
- 8. Community facilities, including facilities for young people
- 9. Retail and economy, including shops, markets, local businesses and car parking
- 10. Closing remarks by the Mayor

All residents are welcome. There is an opportunity to register for the event on the Town Council's website to help with catering, but this is not a requirement and you can simply turn up on the day.

This event will be broadcast live on Wallingford Radio.

We are legally required to hold this meeting before 1 June each year.

The next meeting of the Wallingford Town Council will be held on **Monday, 18 March 2024** at **7.00** pm in the **Town Hall.**
